Goal: Students will be able to type at least 60 wpm with an accuracy rate of 96% by the end of 8th Grade.

- Type in your username and password. (Students must use the log-in information provided by the school.)
- <u>Username</u> is ... the same as your MobyMax username ... <u>meigs_lastnamefirstname</u> (all lower case letters; no spaces; no hyphens ... nothing but letters)
- Password is ... the same as your MobyMax password. New students will receive usernames and passwords at "Meigs 101."
- Click "Log In."
- Students are required to complete a minimum of <u>15</u>
 <u>exercises (screens) per week</u>. The week <u>begins on Monday (even if Monday is a holiday) and ends on Sunday</u>. If there are exceptions to this time frame, you will be notified via Evrits.
- Progress will be checked weekly and a grade will be recorded. Your keyboarding grade will be part of
